Grade 11's must choose English, a Social Studies, a Science, a Math, four electives and two alternates. **No study blocks are allowed.**

Grade 12's must choose English 12 or English First Peoples 12 and Career Life Connections 12 plus six electives and two alternates. One study block is allowed if you have a minimum of three academic courses each Semester.
