Grad Financial Aid

The Grad Council has undertaken a number of fundraising endeavors to pay for students who are experiencing financial hardship. Unfortunately, the Grad Council will NOT pay optional grad activities. The Grad Council will use their fundraising to pay for students who cannot afford to pay for Grad Ceremonies (walking the stage). Grad Convocation

The Ceremony

If you have completed the requirements necessary to graduate, you will be participating in the Grad Ceremony. Students may participate in the graduation ceremonies only if they are taking a course of studies that satisfies the provincial graduation requirements by May 1st. Students enrolled in courses outside of Bateman that are required for graduation must be 80% complete in order to be eligible to take part in the ceremony. If you are not sure if you have completed the requirements, please see your counselor. In addition, all students meeting the required number of course credits to graduate students must be in good standing in their current courses. This includes the completion of grad transition and work experience booklets. Grad fee of \$60-- please pay online.

Grad Valedictorian/ Class Representative

The Valedictorian and Class Representative are members of the graduating class who speaks on behalf of all graduates at the Grad Ceremonies. This honour is usually bestowed on an outstanding male and female of the graduating class. The Valedictorian is chosen by a staff committee and represents all qualities that we value at RBSS: Character, Academic Achievement, Extracurricular Involvement and Community Service. In addition, students may nominate themselves or one of their Grad classmates for Class Representative. A staff committee will review all nominations to ensure candidates for Class Rep. meet the

requirements (B or higher GPA, good conduct, good citizenship, and has made significant contributions to the school) and the final representative will be chosen by a Grade 12 vote. These TWO individuals will be the Grad Valedictorian and Class Representative and will address their Grad Class at Convocation.

Grad Gowns

To cross the stage for the Grad ceremonies, we will need to order you a gown. To do this complete, the GRAD APPLICATION form (done online in June with all grade 11's – see link in grad handbook if you have not filled one in). Students will receive a black gown, and green stole, cap and Grad 2023 tassel. The Grad Gown/Stole/ Cap/ Tassel is yours to keep – enjoy your souvenir. Pick up from the Counselling Centre during lunch, or before or after school at a date to be decided.

Grad Invitations

Two tickets to Convocation are included in the Graduation Fee, however, additional tickets are \$10.00 and can be purchased online or at the school. You can only pick up your invitations if you have paid your \$60 Grad Fee and have no outstanding school fees.

Your tickets/ invitations can be picked up TBA from the office.

Grad Ceremony Rehearsal

It is an absolute must that you are in attendance. Make sure you book the time off work! At the rehearsal you will see the layout of the Entertainment Centre, what line-up you are in, where you will sit and whom you are standing beside plus how to cross the stage without tripping.

Grad Stage Crossing Quotes

Your grad stage crossing quote is read as you cross the stage during grad ceremonies. <u>This is different from your yearbook quote</u>. As grad ceremonies are a formal occasion for your parents in celebration of your achievements, you may thank your parents, acknowledge support, include a meaningful quote etc.

The final day to submit is TBA

Your stage crossing quote is written by you and will be read out loud (by a staff member) as you cross the stage during Grad Ceremonies. It is your chance to give a short statement to your parents, teachers and fellow grads regarding you, your education or your future.

Topics you might include are:

- Plans after you leave Bateman
- What you enjoyed most about Bateman
- A fond memory, a quote, a favourite saying

Long term goals

For example: Serge would like to thank all of his coaches, teachers and fellow students who made Bateman a fun place to be! Rugby rocked and Drama rolled. Serge plans to attend UFV next year.

Rules:

- Write your introduction in third person and do not use "I"
- No longer than three sentences of approximately 30 words or less
- If you do not submit an introduction only your name will be announced as you cross the stage.

Grad Dinner & Dance AKA - Prom Grad Parade

Preceding the Grad Moonlight March grads individually parade / arrive to the school in their vehicle of choice. Arrive in a Fire Truck, Horse and Buggy, Classic Car, or your own vehicle all tripped out or decorated. Due to the out of town location of Prom we will not be individually driving to the Prom venue as per district policy.

What is a Prom DATE ticket?

Bringing a date from outside your grad class (either attending another high school, has graduated, or is in gr. 9-11 at RBSS)? You must complete a **Prom Guest Application Form** available in the office TBA and due no later than TBA. You are asked to pay for your date when

you submit your approval form. If your date is denied, you will receive a full refund. If you have to change dates, this can be accommodated but only if you have an original Guest Approval form in & you have paid for your date. Your guest must be approved in order to book your prom table.

Prom Tables

Students can sign up for tables in Ms. Selzer's room E315, which seat 10, for THREE days only starting TBA. You cannot sign up for a table without paying all of your school fees. It is helpful, if you write all the names of the students sitting at your table down on paper before arriving to pick your table. If any individual at your table hasn't paid their school fees, their name will not be added to your table until they have paid their fees and students may "bump" as there is NO saving of seats.
