COURSE PLANNING REQUIREMENTS:

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Grade 9's must choose English, Math, Science, Social Studies, one PE course, three electives and two alternates. Electives must include at least one Fine Arts and one Applied Skills course.

Grade 10's must choose English, a Math, Science, Social Studies, Career Life Education 10, one PE 10 course, two electives and two alternates.

Grade 11's must choose an English, a Social Studies, a Science, a Math, four electives and two alternates. **No study blocks are allowed.**

Grade 12's must choose English 12 or English First Peoples 12 and Career Life Connections 12 plus six electives and two alternates. One study block is allowed if you have a minimum of three academic courses each Semester.

Effective the 2023/24 school year, all students working toward a B.C. Certificate of Graduation, must successfully complete at least 4 credits in Indigenous-focused coursework.
